**Eligible Discount Fare:** Seniors (65 years or older) and passengers with disabilities, who present a Regional Transit Connection Discount Card or a current Disabled Person Placard Identification card issued by the CA Department of Motor Vehicles or a valid transit discount card issued by another California transit agency which is equivalent to the RTCDC, or those who are **Medicare cardholders** may ride for a discounted fare. The conductor or fare inspector may ask to see a valid ID to verify eligibility or identity. An attendant accompanying a person with a disability also is eligible for this discount when indicated on the RTCDC. Passengers **17 years old and younger** qualify for a discount fare. One child four years old or younger may ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult. Other children must travel with Eligible Discount tickets.

**Ticket Vending Machine**

**Clipper™ card is a reloadable fare payment card that can be used to store Monthly passes, 8-ride tickets and cash.** The card reader at transit stations deducts the cost of a ride. Paper Monthly passes and 8-ride tickets will be phased out early in 2011, and these ticket types will be only available on Clipper. - Must have \$1.25 on card
  - Monthly Pass customers only tag on and off for first trip of month
  - Cash and 8-ride Ticket customers must tag on and off for every trip

**PROOF - of - PAYMENT SYSTEM**

Caltrain is a **Proof-of-Payment** system. **Tickets must be purchased and/or validated before boarding the train.** Tickets are not sold on the train and must be presented for inspection on request. Passengers who do not have a valid ticket are subject to citation and fine.



**REMINDERS**

- Remain behind the yellow line on the main platform until the train comes to a complete stop.
- All strollers must be folded and stored on the luggage rack.
- No smoking in station areas or on trains.
- In case of onboard emergency, the conductor will provide necessary instructions. Please follow these for safety reasons.

**SERVICE INFORMATION**

**BABY BULLET EXPRESS SERVICE** Caltrain's Baby Bullet express service makes it possible to travel between San Francisco and San Jose in less than an hour, stopping at a few popular stations. Caltrain offers 22 weekday commute-hour bullet trains. The red columns indicate Baby Bullet trains.




**LIMITED-STOP SERVICE** The yellow columns on the weekday timetable indicate Limited-stop service: trains that serve fewer stations than local service.

**TIMED TRANSFERS** Caltrain offers timed transfers during commute-hour service in place of local trains making all stops. Passengers may choose to ride a Limited-stop train to the designated transfer points. To locate trains with timed transfers, look for the green boxes on the weekday timetable.

**WEEKEND SERVICE** Hourly local service operates each Saturday and Sunday, serving all regular service stations from San Francisco to San Jose. A shuttle bus operates between the San Jose Diridon and Tamien stations. Caltrain fare policies apply. Please note that the service day begins a little later on Sunday and ends earlier. **Baby Bullet trains will operate on weekends as part of a pilot project.**

**HOLIDAY SERVICE** Caltrain operates the Sunday schedule on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. A modified schedule may be operated the Day after Thanksgiving and on Presidents Day. Details will be posted online three weeks in advance.

**ONBOARD AMENITIES** Caltrain offers many onboard amenities for its passengers, such as a restroom (located in the northernmost car). The following symbols are noted on the outside of the appropriate car offering the amenity:

-  **Access Car** An area is reserved for wheelchair users in the second car from the north end of the train.
-  **Luggage Car** Dedicated luggage racks are available in the third car from the north end of the train. Please sit near your luggage.
-  **Bike Car** Bike space is available in the northernmost car (gallery equipment accommodates 40 bikes; Bombardier trains 48 bikes). Bicycles must be stowed in the designated storage space in the car. Folding bicycles should be folded and stored under the seat in front of you or on the luggage rack but never on the seat next to you. Bicyclists must be age 12 or older. Bicycle riding on the station platforms and ramps is not allowed.
